


Dear Year 1,

Here are some more lovely activities for you to try today or tomorrow.

<p><u>Reading</u></p> 	<p>Read a book for 5-10 minutes today.</p> <p>Look at the front cover of your book. Read the title. Can you predict what the book might be about? What characters might be in the book? What information might you find out?</p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>This week Miss Wilson is going to be telling the story Dear Dinosaur by Chae Strathie and Nicola O'Byrne. Each part of the story will be uploaded onto Seesaw.</p> <p>Today watch Part 2.</p> <p>Can you make a birthday card for the dinosaur?</p> <p><i>Challenge: Can you use the words <b>Dear</b> and <b>from</b>? Can you write some questions for the dinosaur using question marks? ?</i></p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p><u>Place Value - Ordering numbers</u></p> <p>Ask someone in your family to hide some numbers from 0 to 100 around the house or garden.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Go on a number hunt and collect five numbers.</li><li>2. Sort the five numbers you have found in order from the lowest to the highest number.</li></ol> <p>You could use objects to help you count or the number square in your home learning pack.</p>
<p><u>Other activities</u> <u>Computing/Maths &amp; Movie</u></p> 	<p>Can you play the caterpillar ordering game? <a href="https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ordering-and-sequencing/caterpillar-ordering">https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ordering-and-sequencing/caterpillar-ordering</a></p>  <p>Can you watch a movie you've not seen before? Maybe a film about dinosaurs? Can you retell the main events from the story?</p>
