We hope you had an enjoyable and relaxing summer holiday. The children have enjoyed the first couple of weeks in their new classes and we would like to take the opportunity to let you know some important information about the organisation of Year 3 and other matters.

Our sessions – Otter: Wednesday (indoors), Friday (outdoors)

Badger: Monday (indoors), Tuesday (outdoors)

We ask that the children have their full, named PE kits in school at all times. As the weather can be rather unpredictable, sessions may sometimes fall on other days so it is necessary to have kit always available. If children are unable to take out their own earrings, we ask that they refrain from wearing them on PE days or bring tape to cover them.

Painting Aprons

Could we please ask that those children who have not yet brought in a painting apron, do so ASAP as starting from next week, our Art lessons will involve the children collecting resources from the immediate environment, mixing their own paints and painting with them!

Home Learning

Home Learning will be set each week. The new homework will be sent home on a Friday and is due in on the following Thursday. Homework will usually include:

<u>Spellings</u> – These follow a pattern and your child will be tested on these the following Friday. <u>Tables/number facts</u> – Again, your child will be tested so please encourage your child to practise these regularly.

Reading – Children are expected to continue to read at home during the week and over the weekends. In Year Three, we expect that there will be at least five entries written in to their reading diaries by an adult across the week. Children should bring their reading books and diaries into school every day.

Please see the guide stuck in to your child's home learning book and if you have any queries, please see your child's class teacher.

Classroom Support

We would also like to take this opportunity to ask if there are any parents who would be willing to come in and help with reading or other activities within the class. Reading is a very important part of the curriculum. This would involve 25 minutes of your time, hearing individuals read and discussing the

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text with them. Reading sessions take place on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings 8:35 – 9:00. Please complete the slip below if you are able to help.
