<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p>Roald Dahl used similes to describe Charlie's grandparents e.g. 'as shrivelled as prunes' and 'as bony as skeletons'. Can you think of other similes to describe different things in the story - Charlie's house, things inside the chocolate factory, some of the smells inside, what things tasted like? Write these in to your red book.</p>																																																																							
<p><b>Reading</b></p> 	<p>Read some of your reading book and write in your reading diary. Use your bookmark to answer 2 questions.</p>																																																																							
<p><b>Spelling</b></p> 	<p>Choose 4 spellings from either the Year 1 and 2 or 3 and 4 lists to practise. Write them out 3 times and if you are unsure of their meanings, look them up and write these down too.</p>																																																																							
<p><b>Mental Maths</b></p> 	<p>Play on Times Table Rock Stars and Hit the Button. Add your score in to your red book.</p>																																																																							
<p><b>Maths</b></p>  	<p>Can you do some cooking which involves <u>weighing your ingredients</u>? It could be baking a cake or just helping with dinner. You could make your own stamps and use toy money.  <b>Extra Challenge</b> - Can you create your own posting price list based on the item's length and weight?
