Dear Parents and Carers,

Starting on Friday 7th January 2022, Year 4 will be having swimming lessons at Littlehampton Wave. Every Friday morning the children will travel by coach to the centre for this. The swimming lessons will continue up until Friday 8th April 2022.

The cost of the swimming and donation towards the coach is £2.00 per week per child for 13 weeks. This is a voluntary contribution and is required for the swimming to go ahead. Please make your payment via our on-line payments system, ParentMail, and also tick the Parental Consent box giving your permission. **Please note that without sufficient voluntary contributions the swimming may have to be cancelled.** We will shortly set up weekly payments online (this should be ready to pay by today). There is also the option to pay the full amount in total (£26.00) should you wish to do so.

During the first session, trained swimming instructors will assess each child's level of competency and be placed in an appropriate group for their lessons. Swimming is a compulsory part of the national curriculum with the intention that children will be able to perform safe self-rescue and swim competently over a distance of at least 25meters.

The children will need to bring to school:

- An appropriate one piece swimming costume or swimming shorts
- Towel
- A waterproof bag
- Fruit or vegetable snack
- Drink bottle
- Long hair will need to be tied up

If you are able to help with the swimming each week or on a rota please let your child's class teacher know as soon as possible.
