Dear Year 4 Parents,

Re: Swimming Lessons in Year 4

We have managed to secure swimming lessons at The Wave in Littlehampton for your child's swimming lessons for the Summer Term, starting on Monday 22nd April 2024 from 10.00 – 11.00am for **10 weeks** (not including Bank Holiday Monday 6th May and May half term). We will have use of the pool with professional tuition. The year group will be split into two groups, each group swimming for half an hour. School will fund the swimming lessons.

You may be aware that the cost of coaches has gone up considerably over the past two years and this is the largest cost to you for your child to take part in the swimming course. To make it more affordable, we will be funding **half the cost of the coaches** and ask that you pay the other half.

The reduced cost of the coaches is £35.00 per person and we have set up two instalments on ParentMail. This means each swimming lesson costs £3.50. We are asking that each child pays £17.50 per half term totalling £35.00. You will also need to tick the Parental Consent box giving your permission.

This is a voluntary contribution and is required for the swimming to go ahead. **Please note that without sufficient voluntary contributions, the swimming will not go ahead at The Wave and will be cancelled.** There is also the option to pay the full amount in total (£35.00) should you wish to do so.

We would appreciate any volunteers to come and help with swimming. If you are able to help each week or on a rota please let your child's class teacher know as soon as possible.
