
Cobnor Residential Visit

We are looking forward to the Residential visit to Cobnor, PO18 8TE

I should be grateful if you would take the time to read the following points:

- 1. Please drop your child in the field on the left as directed by staff, at 9.30 10.00am on Monday 10th July 2023, where teachers will give further information. (This is earlier than the original time as there is now a morning activity, which starts at 11.00am).
- 2. Where possible, please car share to/from the venue as there is limited parking / drop off space

Cobnor Centre is fortunate to possess a prime location in Chichester harbour, an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Cobnor Activities Centre is close to the border of West Sussex and Hampshire, between Chichester and Portsmouth, on the Chidham peninsula. On the water, they are part of Chichester Harbour at the end of the Bosham Channel, with access to the water at all states of the tide, close to Itchenor, East Head and West Wittering, Hayling Island and Thorney Island. Off the water, the centre is close to the South Downs National Park.



- 3. Please ensure your children's luggage and belongings are <u>clearly</u> labelled and that they are able to carry everything by themselves.
- 4. Any medication must be in a clearly named bag and given to your child's class teacher on arrival. If you need to update your medical form please pop in to the school office before the end of this week.
- 5. Please ensure your child brings a plastic bag containing a packed lunch and a drink. Please use disposable containers as everything will be thrown away after lunch. No fizzy drinks or glass bottles please.
- 6. Please ensure your child comes appropriately dressed (t-shirt, tracksuit trousers/leggings and trainers) ready to commence morning activities.
- 7. Remember to pack a spare plastic bag or 2 for carrying wet clothes to and from the changing rooms.
- 8. Please collect your child from the accommodation buildings at 1.45pm on Friday 14th July. If you are unable to collect your child and would like to authorise someone else to collect them, please let the class teacher know <u>prior</u> to the residential visit.

Your child can bring in something for them to do whilst they are in their rooms for short periods of time e.g. puzzles, reading books or colouring books. <u>Please do not send any electrical items such as ipods, mobile phones or gaming devices.</u> They may bring a camera. Any items brought <u>must</u> be clearly labelled and are your child's responsibility.
