Summer Term Topic – Explore:



We will be:

- Locating the countries of the UK and the counties of England;
- Locating countries of the World countries;

We will study a range of sources of information and focus on developing our map-reading skills.

English Learning

We will be focusing on narrative poetry (e.g. "The Highwayman" by Alfred Noyes). After that, we will read "Blue John" by Berlie Doherty. We will be using these inspiring text as the basis for our own creative writing.

In our guided reading sessions, we will continue reading and discussing "Wonder" by R.J Palacio.



Mathematical Learning

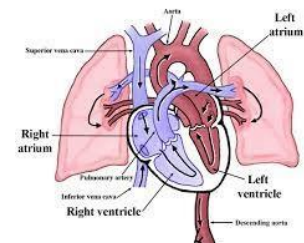

Scientific Learning

Our topic this half term is the human body. We will be focussing on:

- The circulatory system
