Dear Parents,

We are pleased to say that the children have settled in well to their new classes and are getting used to Year 1 routines. We have been grateful for your understanding and cooperation as we have all begun to get used to the new systems in place to keep the school community safe whilst in school.

As part of these measures we need to adapt the way we communicate with you about your child's reading progress. As communicated in a recent text message we are now keeping reading records in school to limit the amount of items travelling to and from school on a daily basis. We will be keeping our own records of your child's progress and will communicate with you when required via Seesaw. We would be grateful if you would make a comment on your child's reading, weekly, in the space provided on the homework sheet. Your child will be heard by either a teacher or LSA on a weekly basis. We will encourage your child to change their books on either a Monday, Wednesday or Friday in class.

Homework will be sent out from next Monday and will be due the following Monday. Along with this we will be sending a book home to complete the work and this needs to remain at home. Again to reduce any risk, please upload a photo of your child's homework to Seesaw rather than sending any paperwork back in to school. We would encourage parents to familiarise themselves with Seesaw for communication as soon as possible as this tool will be used widely in Year 1.

Thank you for your support as we continue to adapt our school routine to prioritise everyone's safety.
