Independence

Children are expected to take responsibility for organising themselves and ensuring they have the correct equipment needed for each day. This includes reading diary, PE kit, etc.

Uniform/PE kit

This year, we are focussing on children looking smart in school. Please ensure your child is wearing correct school uniform each day and that every item is named. PE kit will need to be in school every day, please ensure all items in this are also named.

Mobile Phones

Children who have to bring in their phone because they walk independently to and from school must give their phone to their class teacher each morning, who will keep it in a phone box until the end of the day. It must be turned off whilst in school. Please note phones are brought to school at their owner's risk.

Snack

Children are welcome to bring a snack for break time, but it is expected that this is a piece of fruit or vegetables.

We expect the children to continue with regular reading at home and writing in their diaries to show what they have read.
